



Ed Kelley

Ed Kelley is the Executive Pastor at Christ's Church in Federal Way. Pastor Ed Kelley started with Christ's Church in 1983 at the very inception of the church, becoming CCFW's first Youth Pastor. Ed and his wife Susan served until 1991, when they accepted a call to one of the largest churches in Southern California, Riverlakes Community. Ed and Susan served as an Associate Pastor with Ed's main responsibility being College and Student Ministry. That ministry was blessed going from 30 or so students upon Ed's arrival in 1991 and a handful of volunteer staff people to seeing more than 400 students on campus each week and a volunteer staff of 50+ by the time 1996 rolled around, a short 4-5 years later.

In 1996, Ed came back to CCFW as the Evangelism and Discipleship pastor only to be made Executive Pastor a few months later. In 1999, after an extensive nation-wide search for a new youth pastor that didn't provide any solutions to a vacancy in the Student Ministry, Ed accepted a unique job design: Pastor of Students AND Administration. Several ministry directors, pastors and department managers report directly to Ed while through the use of interns and other support personnel, Ed supervises the entire Student ministry. While performing Executive Pastor duties, he also preached at the Student Church, the College service, and taught Systematic Theology for adults.

Today, Ed is now the Executive Pastor of the Church (another Student Pastor has taken over Student Ministry) and he teaches the College/Career ministry, continues his Systematic Theology class and speaks to many retreats/camps for other churches in the area.
